



Dear WOW Mentor,

We appreciate your interest in mentoring a teen girl, and we hope that you will join us for Generation WOW on **November 7, 2018** from 2pm to 6pm at the Plaza Live.

Mentoring is about creating opportunities that help build the future leaders of the tomorrow by exposing them to the leaders of today. A mentoring relationship is a visible and demonstrable statement in the belief that unlocking the potential of our youth, *particularly young women*, is to our collective betterment. The goal of Generation WOW is to provide a trusted and inspiring experience that forges relationships, inspires dreams, and delivers results that will change the world.

Since 2013, thousands of teen girls, aged 12-17 in grades 8-11, gather for an inspiring program to learn about "**The Positive and The Possible**." It is a high-energy, high-impact program focusing on self-esteem, life planning, social media, cultural bias, and mentorship.

The signature activity is "**The Geraldine Mentor Walk**," a program founded by business leader Gerry Laybourne and hosted in 40 countries. Mentors are paired with teen girls with a professed interest in the mentor's "expertise" and the groups walk and talk for about 45 minutes. The conversation establishes the foundation of a relationship that will inspire the girls and give them an introduction to mentorship and networking.

Mentor Responsibilities:

1. Register
2. Participate in a pre-event training on mentorship
3. Attend the Generation WOW event on November 7th, 2018
4. Follow up with each of your mentees a minimum of 2 times over the school year by email, phone, text, or in person
5. Where possible and if needed, assist with transportation

It is remarkable how contributing a few hours of one's time can make such a big difference in a young woman's life. We can tell you from first-hand experience that what is given, is returned in more than equal measure.
